

# YUKON SOCCER CLUB RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Absolutely no pets allowed on fields during games or scrimmages. This includes pets on leashes or in dog carriers. This is for the protection of all our kids. If a pet is brought to one of your games a Field Marshal will ask them to remove the pet from the field. There are exceptions for service dogs – please consult a board member if you anticipate a service dog coming to one of your team’s games.
2. No smoking allowed on the fields.
3. No alcohol beverages allowed.
4. No weapons allowed.
5. No glass containers allowed.
6. DO NOT PRACTICE ON GAME FIELDS. If you need help finding somewhere to practice please ask a YSC board member and we can give you some places where you can practice. We encourage you to use the space at Taylor Park (North of Main Street/HWY 66 on 11<sup>th</sup> street) for as long as it is not being worked on for new fields. Overuse of the fields for purposes other than games and scheduled scrimmages leaves less than desirable fields for game days. (See amendment to the by-laws for fines imposed for violations of this rule.)
7. Scrimmages can be scheduled on game fields through the scheduler with teams splitting ref frees. Scrimmages consist of 15 minutes warm up and allotted game time between two teams. Fields cannot be used for additional practice time before or after the scrimmage.
8. Do not yell at the referees. If you have an issue with a referee, find a field marshal and discuss it with them.
9. No obscene or offensive language.
10. If there is unsportsmanlike conduct or you have any other issues or you would like addressed please email the board at [questions@yukonsoccer.net](mailto:questions@yukonsoccer.net). We welcome feedback and will address your concerns including putting you on the agenda for the next board meeting if that is required.
11. It is the coach’s responsibility to make sure that parents and players have been informed of these rules and regulations.
